As part of the STIP amendment approval process, FHWA and FTA are required to issue a Federal Planning Finding at the time each STIP amendment is approved. The last Federal Planning Finding (FPF) was issued in conjunction with the approval of ALDOT's Fiscal Year 2024-2027 STIP. The planning processes carried out by ALDOT and the MPOs have not changed significantly since the last FPF was issued on October 1, 2023.

We have reviewed Amendment #19 to the Fiscal Year 2024-2027 STIP (submitted on August 5, 2025) and find that the projects are based on a planning process that substantially meet the requirements of Title 23, U.S.C. and 23 CFR 450, including compliance with provisions of Title VI of the 1964 Civil Rights Act. Re: STIP Amendment No. 19 (Highway Project)

Attached for your approval is an amendment to the Alabama Department of Transportation Statewide Transportation Improvement Program, (STIP) 2024-2027.

We are certifying that the transportation planning process being carried out by ALDOT is in accordance with all applicable requirements.

Our previous balance of the STIP 2024 in fiscal year 2025 was \$932,439,673.82. This will allow us to make the following amendments and have a balance of \$873,989,781.23.

A detailed project listing grouped by section with amending reason listed below.

Section one contains 38 projects that are being added to the STIP totaling \$39,508,186.70.

Section two contains 6 projects that are being deleted from the STIP totaling \$27,887,848.34.

Section three contains 3 projects that had funding increase to STIP totaling \$58,433,323.12.

The Dothan Area, Eastern Shore, Huntsville, Montgomery, Shoals, and Tuscaloosa MPOs have amended their Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) to include necessary projects inside their urbanized area. The revision to their TIPs is attached.

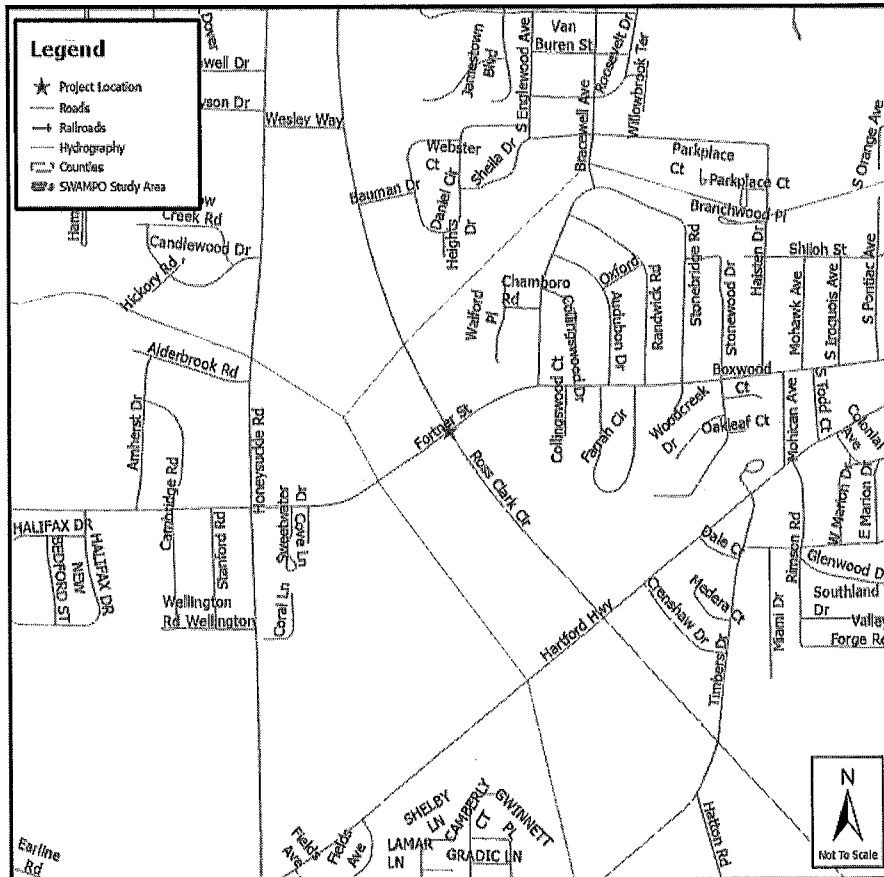

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, Section 11201, November 2021); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, Title 23 USC and 23 CFR 450.324 require that transportation projects in urbanized areas, funded by the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration, be included in a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), amended as often as required, and adopted by the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and


WHEREAS, consistent with the declaration of these provisions, the Eastern Shore MPO, in cooperation with the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT), adopted the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) on September 27, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore MPO desires to amend the FY 2024-2027 TIP as follows:
